Located within the Voyages Ayers Rock Resort complex, the campground is an ideal base from which to experience the beauty of the living cultural landscape of Uluru-Kata Tjuṯa National Park. A well-equipped campground with modern amenities perfectly suited to families, independent travellers and groups.



LOCATION

Voyages Ayers Rock Campground is located at the gateway to the World Heritage listed Uluru - Kata Tjuṯa National Park, just 6km from Ayers Rock Airport.

GETTING THERE

- Regular flights are available from most Australian capital cities to Ayers Rock Airport
- A complimentary transfer service operates from the airport direct to Voyages Ayers Rock Campground
- Self drive is also a popular option with the drive from Alice Springs taking around 4½ hours.

ACCOMMODATION

Voyages Ayers Rock Campground is located on 8 hectares of land and consists of a number of accommodation options to suit your budget. These include:

Cabins

The Campground Cabins offers two rooms, accommodating up to 6 people, with a double bed and two sets of single bunks. Within easy access to all facilities, each cabin features air-conditioning, linen, fully self contained kitchen including utensils, microwave, refrigerator, dining table and chairs, as well as a television.

Camping – Powered Sites

The Campground consists of 198 Powered Camping Sites which are spacious offering plenty of room to relax. Each site is featured on a shaded and grassed area with power for added comfort – electrical outlets 240/250 Volt, 50Hz AC. Close to all facilities.

Camping – Non-Powered Sites

Spacious tent sites without power on grassed area. Located within close proximity to shared facilities including kitchen, guest laundry and gas BBQ's. The Campground also features prepared fire pits (with BYO firewood) for campers to use (outside of fire ban season).

Camping – Coaches

There are 6 coach sites catering to larger groups. Coach Crew including drivers and guides stay complimentary (for camping only).

CLIMATE

Throughout all four seasons you'll find large temperature ranges between day and night. During the Australian summer months, temperatures range from 18°C/64°F (night) to 48°C/118°F (day). In the winter months, temperatures range from 0°C/32°F (night) to 30°C/86°F (day).

WHAT TO BRING

Humidity is low in the arid Red Centre. Days are sunny and can be hot, with cooler nights that can become quite crisp and cold in winter. You will need solid walking shoes, comfortable casual clothes and layers of warmer clothes if you are travelling in the cooler months. Hat and sunscreen are essential all year round.

ACCESS

Air

Qantas flies directly to Ayers Rock Airport from Sydney, Melbourne, Perth and Cairns each day, with connecting flights from Darwin, Alice Springs, Adelaide, Brisbane and Hobart.

Coach

Complimentary return coach transfers from Ayers Rock Airport to Ayers Rock Campground meet every scheduled flight. A free shuttle bus service is also available for transport within the Resort. Shuttle bus circulates Ayers Rock Resort (including campground) daily (10:30am to 6.00pm and 6.30pm to 12.30am) and departs approximately every 20 minutes.

Self Drive

Self drive is a popular option with the drive from Alice Springs to Uluru (Ayers Rock) taking approximately 4½ hours, following the Stuart and Lasseters Highway.

All the major national car hire companies operate out of Alice Springs. Avis, Hertz and Thrifty car rentals are also available at Ayers Rock Resort. You can choose from a range of vehicles including 4WDs or standard sedan options. Pre-book your car hire with Voyages – special rates apply!
