Touring Options	
<p>There are many touring options available in Central Australia. The following information is designed to help you take full advantage of the many experiences available to you during your visit to Alice Springs. We strongly recommend that you pre-book all touring to avoid disappointment. Bookings can be made with the Voyages Travel Centre. Please visit our website for additional touring options.</p>	
<p>Hot Air Ballooning – Outback Ballooning</p> <p>After pick up from your hotel, your pre-dawn ballooning adventure begins alongside the majestic MacDonnell Ranges. Once inflated and in-flight, witness the delicate colours of daybreak against the backdrop of the awesome MacDonnell Ranges. After your flight, enjoy a traditional Balloonist breakfast, where you will be waited on by your pilot and crew. During breakfast you will be presented with a personalized souvenir flight certificate. <p>Quad Biking – Outback Quad Adventures</p> <p>Quad Rush This tour includes a short transfer from the resort in Alice Springs to Undoolya Cattle Station, only 17km east of town centre. This is the oldest working cattle station in the NT. The adventure allows for a guided tour with commentary.</p> <p>Undoolya Discovery. This is a 3.5 hour adventure which allows an exciting experience of Undoolya Station and this unique outback area with its varied wildlife. The adventure allows for a guided tour with commentary.</p> <p>Children 12 to 16 years may participate on any tour with written parental consent. Children under the age of 12 years may travel as a pillion passenger on the guide's bike.</p> <p>Tour Departures Pick up at 8am or 2pm, 1st May to 30th September Pick up at 7am or 3pm, 1st October to 30th April</p> <p>Cancellations within 72 hours of touring, incurs a 100% cancellation fee</p>	<p><u>2.5 hour</u> \$120 per person</p> <p><u>3.5 hour</u> \$195 per person</p>
<p>½ Day A Town Like Alice Tour – AAT Kings</p> <p>Tour the sights of Alice Springs including the historic Telegraph Station and the Royal Flying Doctor Service. Learn how this marvelous facility operates to provide a "Mantle of Safety" to the people of the outback. Visit the School of the Air, where sometimes we are able to listen to the children take lessons on air. Visit the Alice Springs Reptile Centre where we see unique Central Australian reptiles such as the Perentie lizard and Thorny Devil. We also take in the panoramic view of Alice Springs from Anzac Hill.</p> <p>Departs approximately 2pm daily and returns approximately 6pm. 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<p>1 Day West MacDonnell Ranges & Gorges Tour (lunch included) – AAT Kings</p> <p>Travel west from Alice Springs following the spectacular West MacDonnell Ranges. Pass the John Flynn Memorial (founder of the Royal Flying Doctor Service). Stop at Simpsons Gap with its lovely river red gum scenery. Continue on to magical Standley Chasm. Walk into the Chasm along the stony watercourse lines with cycads, ghost gums, acacias and cypress pines. Travel to Ellery Creek Big Hole, before arriving at Ormiston Gorge. We travel onto Glen Helen Gorge, a semi permanent waterhole. Lunch is included today and depending on the time of the year a refreshing swim may be possible at one of the waterholes visited. Nearby is Mt Sonder lookout. This beautiful mountain was the subject of many paintings by the famed Aboriginal artist Albert Namatjira. We travel past the famous twin Ghost gums on our way back into Alice Springs.</p> <p>Departs at 7.30am May to September inclusive returning approximately 5.00pm.</p> <p>Cancellations within 1-6 days of touring, incurs a 50% cancellation fee</p>	<p>\$123 per adult \$62 per child</p>
<p>1 Day Palm Valley Safari by 4WD (picnic lunch included) – AAT Kings</p> <p>This one day 4WD Safari travels through the West MacDonnell Ranges to Hermannsburg, an Aboriginal community and historic precinct which is renowned for its Aboriginal art collection and the works of Albert Namatjira. Then travel down the bed of the Finke River, one of the oldest watercourses in the world, into Palm Valley. See spectacular rock forms, white sands and an oasis of rock pools and palm trees. Visit the spectacular rock formation known as the Amphitheatre. On the return journey, relax and enjoy watching the changing colours of the magnificent West MacDonnell Ranges in the afternoon sunlight.</p> <p>Departs at 7:30am daily, returning at approximately 6.00pm. Tour operates Mon, Wed, Thu, Sat & Sun. Price includes return hotel transfers, entry fees and lunch.</p> <p>Cancellations within 1-6 days of touring, incurs a 50% cancellation fee</p>	<p>\$159 per adult \$80 per child (15yrs & under)</p>
<p>1-Day Uluru Adventure (picnic dinner included) – AAT Kings</p> <p>Travel south from Alice Springs through the MacDonnell Ranges. Pause at Jim's Place for a breakfast stop (own expense). Stop at the Atila (Mt. Conner) lookout and enjoy morning tea. There may be time for a camel ride (own expense) at Curtin Springs, before traveling onto Uluru Kata Tjuta National Park. Join a base tour of Uluru, including a guided walk to Mutitjulu Waterhole where you can view aboriginal rock paintings. Visit the Uluru Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre and learn more about Tjukurpa (law) of the Anangu people. There may be time to climb Uluru (conditions permitting). Visit Kata Tjuta, where you can take a walk between the massive domes at Walpa Gorge. Travel back to the Uluru sunset viewing area. Witness sunset and the changing colours of Uluru whilst sipping sparkling wine or juice, followed by a sunset buffet dinner. After dinner, return to Alice Springs.</p> <p>Departs at 6.30am daily from Alice Springs, returning at approximately 11.30pm to Alice Springs.</p> <p>Cancellations within 1-6 days of touring, incurs a 50% cancellation fee</p>	<p>\$237 per adult \$119 per child (15yrs & under)</p>
<p>Alice Springs Desert Park – Tailormade Tours</p> <p>In the space of a few hours or a day discover the secrets of the desert. See and hear the stories of the plants, animals, and local Aboriginal culture at daily guide presentations. Witness free-flying birds of prey, see rare and endangered animals and enjoy a cinematic journey of the creation of these deserts.</p> <p>Scheduled transfers operate daily from all hotels departing at 7:30am, 9:00am, 11:30am, 2:00pm, and 4:00pm and returning from the Alice Springs Desert Park at 9:30am, 12:00pm, 2:30pm, 4:30pm, and 6:00pm.</p> <p>Cancellations within 24 hours of touring, incurs a 100% cancellation fee.</p>	<p>\$40 per adult \$28 per child (2-14 yrs)</p>
<p>Outback Bush BBQ Dinner Tour – Tailormade Tours</p> <p>Set in the East MacDonnell Ranges enjoy a pleasant and relaxing evening around the campfire with a fine meal of prime Central Australian beef. This fun filled evening of entertainment and outback cuisine in the atmosphere of an early cattle camp is as unique as the Australian outback itself. Tour includes boomerang throwing demonstration, local cattleman's talk, damper making, indigenous talk, entertainment - bush balladeer, star gazing by local astronomer, transport, 3 course meal (including Scotch fillet steak and sausages) and all beverages (wine, beer and soft drink).</p> <p>Cancellations within 24 hours of touring, incurs a 100% cancellation fee.</p>	<p>\$139 per adult \$84 per child (2-14 yrs)</p>
