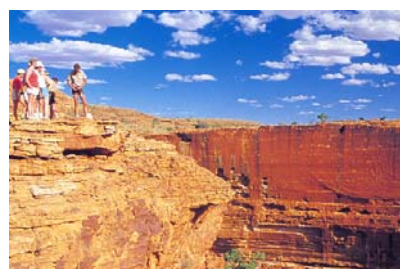

<p>Sounds of Firelight Dining Experience</p> <p>Imagine the romance of a table for two in a wilderness setting under a canopy of the Southern Night sky. The only light comes from the moon and the flickering glow of the fire. The only sound is from the whispering of the breeze through the Desert Oak trees and the crackling flames. While you soak up the atmosphere, a superb four course set menu is served, accompanied by some of Australia's finest wines. This is Sounds of Firelight, an exclusive dining experience at Kings Canyon Resort. It's designed for intimacy and romance with no more than eight couples dining on any one night. Sounds of Firelight is a fantastic way to unwind after a day hiking through Kings Canyon and Watarrka National Park.</p> <p>Tour commences 30 minutes prior to sunset. Duration is approx 4 hours. <p>Kings Canyon Climb – AAT Kings</p> <p>Join a guided climb to the rim of Kings Canyon. Marvel at the breathtaking views of Watarrka National Park and into the canyon itself before descending into the green oasis of the 'Garden of Eden'. The walk is rocky and steep in places and is recommended for those with a good level of fitness. Alternatively you may wish to explore the canyon floor, an easier shady walk that follows a trail between the two sheer walls of the canyon.</p> <p>Departs daily (except Monday) between 5.00am and 8.30am depending sunrise time and on prevailing weather conditions. Duration of tour is approximately 3 1/2 hours.</p> <p>Cancellation within 1 – 6 days of touring incurs a 50% cancellation fee</p>	<p>\$58.00 per adult</p> <p>\$29.00 per child (0-15 years)</p>
<p>Helicopter Flights – Professional Helicopter Services A minimum of 2 people and maximum 4 people per flight applies.</p> <p>Kings Canyon & Carmichaels Crag (15 minutes) An aerial tour is the only way to fully appreciate the scale and grandeur of this spectacular Canyon and the rugged region surrounding it as you fly over Kings Canyon, the domes of the Lost City and the Garden of Eden, then along Kings Creek and over to Carmichael Crag. Tour includes complimentary pick-up from Kings Canyon Resort.</p> <p>Kings Canyon, Crag and George Gill Range (30 minutes) Make the most of your trip by extending the Kings Canyon tour to take in the Watarrka Lookout, Kings Creek and fly along the spectacular cliffs of the George Gill Range to Carmichael Crag before returning via the Hidden Valley. <p>Quad Adventures – Kings Creek Station</p> <p>A guided tour of Kings Creek Station on your own 4-wheel quad bike – an adventure you'll never forget. Journey through the rugged outback taking in spectacular scenery whilst riding through wild bush and over red sand dunes searching for wildlife. Learn a little about outback station life from the stockmen guides as you pause to view the splendor of the George Gill Range. Your adventure takes you through the cattle country where you will often see santa/shorthorn cattle and, occasionally, surprising feral camels, kangaroos and dingoes. Majestic wedge-tailed eagles are often sighted, gliding in the sky looking for prey, while below colourful parrots and other native bird life flit around the scrub. Take the late afternoon tour and enjoy a magnificent sunset at the secluded lookout. Price includes your quad bike hire and helmet. Don't forget to bring a water bottle and your camera.</p> <p>Departs daily on demand. Duration of the tour is 30 minutes, 1 hour or 2½ hours. Minimum age is 16 years We recommend you wear long pants and enclosed shoes.</p> <p><i>Please note that Quad Adventure tours leave from <u>Kings Creek Station</u> that is approximately 20 minutes drive south of the Resort. <p>Camel Rides – Kings Creek Station</p> <p>Enjoy a 1 hour ride on a friendly camel at Kings Creek Station. The camel train is led by an experienced guide who will be happy to answer your questions and take your photograph. The camel's easy gait and comfortable, individually designed saddles ensure a safe and pleasant ride. A loading platform is used for your safety and convenience and to reduce strain on the camel joints. Tours depart from Kings Creek Station. Helmets are provided. Child pricing applies to 5-14 year olds, inclusive.</p> <p>Camel tours available: Sunrise Spectacular (1 hour) – Your experienced guide leads your camel through the red sands to view desert oaks, wildflowers and some of the abundant bird-life in our area.</p> <p>Sunset Spectacular (1 hour) - A relaxing guided tour as the sun sets against the brilliant George Gill Range. <i>Please note that Camel Rides leave from <u>Kings Creek Station</u> that is approximately 20 minutes drive south of the Resort.
