



3-DAY WEEKEND AWAY

ULURU-KATA TJUTA NATIONAL PARK – NORTHERN TERRITORY

If you're planning a romantic getaway or a weekend with your girlfriends but are looking for something a little different then spend the weekend discovering Australia's heart. - Enjoy a BBQ dinner at the Outback Pioneer, play some pool and listen to some great live music in a relaxed and vibrant atmosphere. Alternatively, go for the full fine dining experience at Kuniya Restaurant located at 5-star Sails in the Desert

DAY 3

- Take a sunrise camel ride tour and have fun discovering the outback a different way
- Tour to the massive domes of Kata Tjuta and take a walk at Walpa Gorge.
