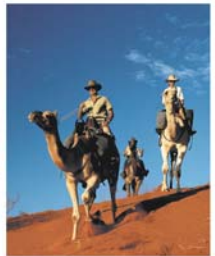

Walking Track Legend

Some tours operating within the Uluru Kata-Tjuta National Park involve some walking on tracks. Most of the walks around the base of Uluru are flat and easy, where some of the walks around Kata Tjuta can be more moderate in difficulty, with slopes and rocky paths. When both symbols appear, the track is considered to be Easy to Moderate, or in some cases there are 2 tracks to choose from.

Aboriginal Uluru Tour - Anangu Tours

After watching the beautiful sunrise with tea and coffee, you will enjoy a delicious continental breakfast at the Ininti Café overlooking Uluru. After breakfast join your Aboriginal guide and language interpreter on the famous Liru Walk and retrace the path of the Liru Ancestors through the bushland near Uluru. See demonstrations of ancient bush skills such as making kiti (bush glue), making fire without matches and carving wooden tools with only a sharpened stone. Learn to hold and throw a spear. The tour ends at the base of the climb Mala car park.

Mala Walk Tour - Anangu Tours

This tour to Uluru includes free time at the Uluru Cultural Centre and then the Aboriginal guided Mala Walk. Along the trail, visit the caves along the base of Uluru and learn the sensitive story of the Mala (Rufous Hare Wallaby) people who lived at Uluru, with their friend the Itjaritjari (marsupial mole). The tour ends at Kantju Gorge, a beautiful rock hole at the base of a dramatic rock face.

Uluru Sunrise & Guided Cultural Walk - AAT Kings

Rise early and travel to the Uluru sunrise viewing area, Talinguru nyakunytjaku, to watch the first rays of the sun light up Uluru and the Red Centre. After sunrise accompany your Guide on the Mala Walk, which takes you through one of the most important habitation areas for the Aboriginal people over thousands of years. Continue to Kantju Gorge, where after rainfall, water can cascade over the side of Uluru and plunge some 90 metres to the ground. We drive to the site of the Mutitjulu Walk where your guide will indicate the natural features of the landscape, Aboriginal rock paintings and relay traditional stories relating to this special place. The waterhole was once an important water source for Anangu (the local Aboriginal people). Walk towards Kuniya Piti, a sacred site at Uluru. Board your coach and continue your tour around the circumference of this massive rock with commentary from your Guide. Later visit the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre, for the opportunity to learn more about Anangu and Tjukurpa (Anangu beliefs and law). There is also the chance to view and purchase locally made Aboriginal souvenirs. Tea or Coffee and biscuits are included in this tour.

You will return to Ayers Rock Resort approx 30mins prior to the Sounds of Silence pick up time.

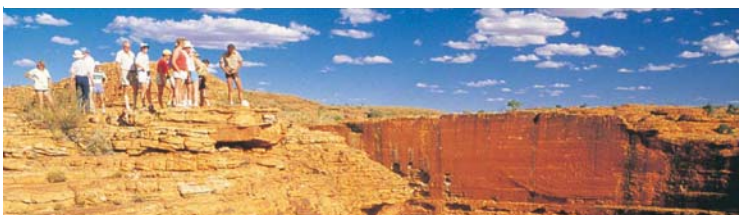
