ACCESS

Air

Qantas flies directly to Ayers Rock Airport from Sydney, Perth, Cairns and Alice Springs. Virgin Blue flies directly to Ayers Rock Airport daily from Sydney.

Both airlines provide connecting flights from most major domestic destinations.

Coach

Complimentary return coach transfers from Ayers Rock Airport to Ayers Rock Resort meet every scheduled flight. A free shuttle bus service is also available for transport within the Resort. Shuttle bus circulates Ayers Rock Resort daily (10:30am to 6.00pm and 6.30pm to 12.30am) and departs approximately every 20 minutes.

Self Drive

Self drive is a popular option with the drive from Alice Springs to Ayers Rock Resort taking approximately 4½ hours, following the Stuart and Lasseters Highway.

Major national car hire companies operate out of Alice Springs and Ayers Rock Resort. You can choose from a range of vehicles including 4WDs or standard sedan options. Pre-booking is recommended.
